

The Hierarchy of Road Users

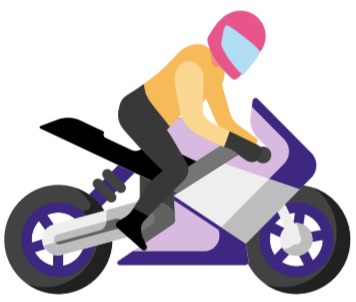
The Hierarchy of Road Users establishes a priority system - road users who are most vulnerable to harm are given priority over those who have greater potential to cause harm.



Pedestrians



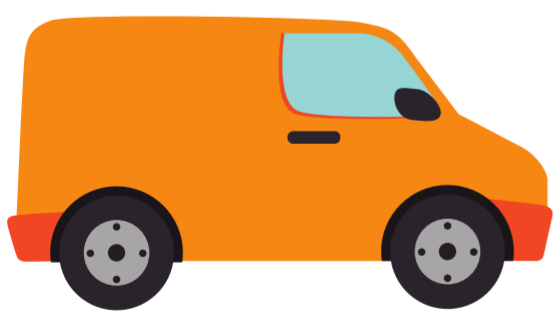
Cyclists & Horse Riders
