Start at Mevagissey, a picture-perfect authentic Cornish fishing village, and follow the winding coast south-west. Visit the 500 year old Pendennis Castle, before striking out to Lizard Point (we'd recommend prioritising Lizard over Lands End), and ending the trip at stunning St Michael's Mount.

You'll experience some of the best vistas and hospitality Cornwall has to offer, and create memories to last a lifetime.



Key route points: Mevagissey, Pendennis Castle, Lizard Point, St Michael's Mount, and Penzance.
